

HEMATO-ONCOLOGY DEPARTMENT WITH DAY CHEMOTHERAPY SUB-DIVISION

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The Department of Hematooncology with the Subdepartment of Day Chemotherapy deals with the treatment of patients with haematological malignancies, both of the lymphatic system (chronic lymphocytic leukemia, Hodgkin's lymphoma, multiple myeloma, amyloidosis) and hematopoietic (acute leukemia, myelodysplastic syndromes, myelofibrosis).

Head of the Department prof. dr hab.n.med. Joanna Góra-Tybor is an experienced specialist in hematology and internal medicine, the author of numerous scientific publications, and a lecturer at scientific conferences. Her scientific interests include primarily myeloproliferative neoplasms.

The ward has access to all drug programs of the National Health Fund for patients with haematological malignancies, which is a prerequisite for modern, targeted chemo and immunotherapy. In addition, access to numerous clinical trials provides the opportunity to apply the latest treatment options. Therapies are conducted both in the stationary mode (in the case of using treatment regimens requiring hospitalization) and "day" mode with hospitalization only for the purpose of administering drugs.
